

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the fork carriage hoisting capacity, there are actually four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

Class I carriages are rated for loads as much as 2000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for Class I is thirteen inches. Class II carriages are rated for loads as much as 5,550 lbs. Their carriage bar spacing is sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for loads as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is twenty inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is 25 inches.

The carriages for pin type blades may be different depending on the maker. Pin mounted blades may vary by the amount of offset between the fork eye and the tine. Carriage capacity would be established by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
